

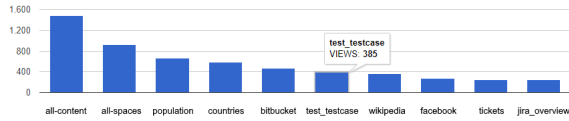
Top Queries

```
SELECT QUERY_NAME,
       COUNT(ID) AS VIEWS
FROM AO_AD3311_MACRO_USAGE
GROUP BY QUERY_NAME
ORDER BY VIEWS desc
LIMIT 10;
```

TIP: Add a WHERE clause to see the top 10 queries of the month, or week. For MySQL you could use this:

```
WHERE DATE >= DATE_ADD(CURDATE(), INTERVAL -7 DAY)
```
